PURPOSE STATEMENT

In a world where few things are believed in, strictly by faith, how can Christians convince skeptics of the eternal existence of Jesus Christ? We, as believers, are blessed with a faith that is given to us free of charge and is tenderly cared for by the Holy Spirit of God. This Spirit indwells us from the moment we take our blessed Savior into our lives and establish the beginning of a personal relationship with Him. The dilemma comes from those who require more than faith to believe. Where can evidence be found that would prove to the world that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and man, and is the blessed Messiah that has been promised in Holy Scripture?

The Jewish nation adheres only to the Torah, or as Christians call it, the Old Testament of the Holy Bible. Actually, there are the Law (5 books), the Prophets (8 books) and the Writings (11 books). As Christians we have much to learn from the wonderful and colorful world of Judaism.

“The five Rolls were read yearly at Feasts: *

Song, at Passover, allegorically referring to the Exodus.

Ruth, at Pentecost, celebrating Harvest.

Esther, at Purim, commemorating Deliverance from Haman.

Ecclesiastes, at Tabernacles, most joyous of Feasts.

Lamentations, 9th of Ab, commemorating Destruction of Jerusalem.

The Septuagint (Greek word for Pentateuch) translators re-classified the Old Testament books according to subject-matter. English translators followed the Septuagint order, as we now have them.” They (our Jewish brothers and sisters) do not subscribe to the New Testament since they are not as yet convinced that Jesus was, and is, the Messiah that the Law, the Prophets and the Writings spoke of.

Jesus, Himself, said that He did not come to abolish the Law and the Prophets, but to fulfill them. This word, fulfill, is a very important word since He is the only person to ever have completely adhered to all of the requirements set forth by God in His holy Word...written long before Jesus' birth and ministry on earth.

Throughout the Old Testament, prophets foretold of the coming of the Christ, or Messiah. The Blessed One of God. His birth, death and Ministry were all prophesied in great detail by these religious men as you will read in this guide. A great many wonderful miracles and “signs” were performed by and near Christ, and these events continue to influence mankind in our lives even today, some 2,000 years after His birth.

The prophets foretold of one (John the Baptist) that would come before the Messiah to prepare

His way, and also predicted the difficulties and persecution Christ would face in His life and Ministry on earth. Much of what occurred in Jesus' life was accurately prophesied, long before His birth, and this guide should help you attach the prophecies with the fulfillments. Then, hopefully, when you continue your study of the Holy Bible, you will have acquired a basic understanding of the fulfillment of prophecy.

Perhaps if the Jewish nation could be shown from the very sacred text that they hold so strictly to, that Jesus of Nazareth was, and is, the Messiah that they have long awaited; a significant platform for discussion, a "door" if you will, could be opened. It is my solemn prayer that hopefully a study such as the one I have enclosed, could become a seed, planted for positive discussions to sprout from. The fertile soil has already been provided by the Lord, for the fields are ripe and the harvest is ready for the gathering.

For Jesus said: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them..." Matt. 5:17 (NIV).

PROPHETIC FOUNDATIONS

With Man's limited knowledge, there is only so much one can expect of him or herself. I have prayed earnestly for Divine guidance to assemble this study guide, knowing full-well that I could never completely understand the wonderful mystery and complexity of our Heavenly Father.

There are no doubt many numerous other prophecies that were fulfilled through, and because of, our marvelous and merciful Savior and Redeemer, Christ Jesus; than those I've mentioned in this book. But perhaps those that have been noted will help to inspire you, the reader, to search for more.

This guide will take you on a chronological journey through the New Testament, correlating the appropriate Old Testament prophecies. Two particular passages seemed to touch me spiritually, and I would like to share them with you prior to the chronological break-downs. They are Isaiah 52:13-15, 53:1-12 and Acts 13:13-52.

Also, a foundation for the New Covenant that would come with Jesus Christ was profoundly foretold in Isaiah 59:20, 21 and Jeremiah 31:31-34.

THE BOOK OF ISAIAH, THE PROPHET

Chapter 52, verses 13 through 15:

“The Suffering and Glory of the Servant”

“See, my servant will act wisely;
he will be raised and lifted up and highly exalted.

Just as there were many who were appalled at him-
his appearance was so disfigured
beyond that of any man
and his form marred beyond human likeness-
so will he sprinkle many nations,
and kings will shut their mouths
because of him.

For what they were not told, they will see,
and what they have not heard,
they will understand.”

Chapter 53, verses 1 through 12:

“Who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?
He grew up before him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of dry ground.
He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him,
nothing in his appearance that we should desire him.

He was despised and rejected by men,
a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering.
Like one from whom men hide their faces
he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
Surely he took up our infirmities
and carried our sorrows,
yet we considered him stricken by
God, smitten by him, and afflicted.

But he was pierced for our transgressions,
he was crushed for our iniquities;
the punishment that brought us
peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

We all, like sheep, have gone astray,
each of us has turned to his own way;
and the Lord has laid on him
the iniquity of us all.

He was oppressed and afflicted,
yet he did not open his mouth;
he was led like a lamb to the slaughter,
and as a sheep before her shearers
is silent, so he did not open his mouth.

By oppression and judgment he
was taken away.
And who can speak of his descendants?

For he was cut off from the land of the living;
for the transgression of my people
he was stricken.

He was assigned a grave with the
wicked, and with the rich in his death,
though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth.
Yet it was the Lord's will to crush
him and to cause him suffer,
and though the Lord makes his
life a guilt offering,
he will see his offspring and prolong
his days,
and the will of the Lord will
prosper in his hand.

After the suffering of his soul,
he will see the light of life and be
satisfied;
by his knowledge my righteous
servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities.

Therefore I will give him a portion among the great,
and he will divide the spoils with the strong,
because he poured out his life unto death,
and was numbered with the transgressors.
For he bore the sin of many,
and made intercession for the transgressors.”

PROPHETIC FOUNDATIONS (continued)

THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

Chapter 13, verses 13 through 52:

“In Pisidian Antioch”

“From Paphos, Paul and his companions sailed to Perga in Pamphylia, where John left them to return to Jerusalem. From Perga they went on to Pisidian Antioch. On the Sabbath they entered the synagogue and sat down.

After the reading from the Law and the Prophets, the synagogue rulers sent word to them, saying, “Brothers, if you have a message of encouragement for the people, please speak.”

Standing up, Paul motioned with his hand and said: “Men of Israel and you Gentiles who worship God, listen to me! The God of the people of Israel chose our fathers; he made the people prosper during their stay in Egypt, with mighty power he led them out of that country, he endured their conduct for about forty years in the desert, he overthrew seven nations in Canaan and gave their land to his people as their inheritance. All this took about 450 years.

“After this, God gave them judges until the time of Samuel the prophet. Then the people asked for a king, and he gave them Saul son of Kish, of the tribe of Benjamin, who ruled forty years. After removing Saul, he made David their king. He testified concerning him:

‘I have found David son of Jesse a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.’

“From this man’s descendants God has brought to Israel the Savior Jesus, as he promised. Before the coming of Jesus, John preached repentance and baptism to all the people of Israel. As John was completing his work, he said: ‘Who do you think I am? I am not that one. No, but he is coming after me, whose sandals I am not worthy to untie.’

“Brothers, children of Abraham, and you God-fearing Gentiles, it is to us that this message of salvation has been sent. The people of Jerusalem and their rulers did not recognize Jesus, yet in condemning him they fulfilled the words of the prophets that are read every Sabbath. Though they found no proper ground for a death sentence, they asked Pilate to have him executed. When they had carried out all that was written about him, they took him down from the tree and laid him in a tomb. But God raised him from the dead, and for many days he was seen by those who had traveled with him from Galilee to Jerusalem. They are now his witnesses to our people.

“We tell you the good news: what God promised our fathers he has fulfilled for us, their children, by raising up Jesus. As it is written in the second Psalm:

“‘You are my Son;
today I have become your Father.’

The fact that God raised him from the dead, never to decay, is stated in these words:

“‘I will give you the holy and sure blessings promised to David.’

So it is stated elsewhere:

“You will not let your Holy One see decay.’

For when David had served God’s purpose in his own generation, he fell asleep; he was buried with his fathers and his body decayed. But the one whom God raised from the dead did not see decay.

“Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you. Through him everyone who believes is justified from everything you could not be justified from by the Law of Moses. Take care that what the prophets have said does not happen to you:

“Look, you scoffers,
wonder and perish,
for I am going to do something in
your days that you would never believe,
even if someone told you.”

As Paul and Barnabas were leaving the synagogue, the people invited them to speak further about these things on the next Sabbath. When the congregation was dismissed, many of the Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who talked with them and urged them to continue in the grace of God.

On the next Sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord. When the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and talked abusively against what Paul was saying.

Then Paul and Barnabas answered them boldly: “We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life, we now turn to the Gentiles. For this is what the Lord has commanded us:

“I have made you a light for the Gentiles,
that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.”

When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who were appointed for eternal life believed.

The word of the Lord spread through the whole region. But the Jews incited the God-fearing women of high standing and the leading men of the city. They stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region. So they shook the dust from their feet in protest against them and went to Iconium. And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

NEW COVENANT FOUNDATIONS

THE BOOK OF ISAIAH THE PROPHET

Chapter 59, verses 20, 21:

“The Redeemer will come to Zion,
to those in Jacob who repent of their sins,”
declares the Lord.

“As for me, this is my covenant with them,” says the lord.

“My Spirit, who is on you, and my words that I have put in your mouth
will not depart from your mouth, or from the mouths of your children,
or from the mouths of their descendants from this time on and forever,”
says the Lord.

JEREMIAH 31:31-34:

“The time is coming,” declares the Lord,
“when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah.
It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers
when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt,
because they broke my covenant, though I was a husband to them,”
declares the Lord.

“This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel
after that time,” declares the Lord.

“I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts.

"If anyone injures his neighbor, whatever he has done must be done to him: fracture for fracture, eye for eye, tooth for tooth. As he has injured the other, so he is to be injured."

19.) PROPHECY

DEUTERONOMY 19:19-21:

"then do to him as he intended to do to his brother. You must purge the evil from among you. The rest of the people will hear of this and be afraid, and never again will such an evil thing be done among you. Show no pity: life for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 5:38-42:

"You have heard that it was said, 'Eye for eye, tooth for tooth.' But I tell you, Do not resist an evil person. If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also. And if some one wants to sue you and take your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. If someone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles. Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you."

20.) PROPHECY:

LEVITICUS 19:18:

"Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against one of your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 5:43-48:

"You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I tell you: love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? Be perfect, therefore, as your Heavenly Father is perfect."

21.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:4, 5:

"Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 8:14-17:

"When Jesus came into Peter's house, he saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed with a fever. He touched her hand and the fever left her, and she got up and began to wait on him. When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: 'He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases.'"

22.) PROPHECY:

HOSEA 6:6:

"For I desire mercy, not sacrifice, and acknowledgment of God rather than burnt offerings."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 9:12, 13:

"On hearing this, Jesus said, 'It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice. ' For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.'"

23.) PROPHECY:

MICAH 7:6, 7:

"For a son dishonors his father, a daughter rises up against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law-a man's enemies are the members of his own household. But as for me, I watch in hope for the Lord, I wait for God my Savior; my God will hear me."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 10:34-36:

"Do not suppose that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. For I have come to turn 'A man against his father, a daughter against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law-a man's enemies will be the members of his own household.'"

24.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 35:5, 6:

"Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. Then will the lame leap like a deer, and the mute tongue shout for joy. Water will rush forth in the wilderness and streams in the desert."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 11:4, 6:

"Jesus replied, "Go back and report to John what you hear and see: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor."

25.) PROPHECY:

MALACHI 3:1:

"See, I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come,' says the Lord Almighty."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 11:7-10:

"As John's disciples were leaving, Jesus began to speak to the crowd about John: 'What did you go out to see? A reed swayed by the wind? If not, what did you go out to see? A man dressed in fine clothes? No, those who wear fine clothes are in king's palaces. Then what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet. This is the one about whom it is written: 'I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way before you.'"

26.) PROPHECY:

HOSEA 6:6:

"For I desire mercy, not sacrifice, and acknowledgment of God rather than burnt offerings."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 12:5-8:

"Or haven't you read in the law that on the Sabbath the priests in the temple desecrate the day and yet are innocent? I tell you that one greater than the temple is here. If you had known what these words mean, 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice,' you would not have condemned the innocent. For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."

27.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 42:1-4:

"Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him and he will bring justice to the nations. He will not shout or cry out, or raise his voice in the streets. A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out. In faithfulness he will bring forth justice; he will not falter or be discouraged till he establishes justice on earth. In his law the islands will put their hope."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 12:14-21:

"But the Pharisees went out and plotted how they might kill Jesus. Aware of this, Jesus withdrew from that place. Many followed him, and he healed all their sick, warning them not to tell who he was. This was to fulfill what was spoken through

the prophet Isaiah: 'Here is my servant whom I have chosen, the one I love, in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will proclaim justice to the nations. He will not quarrel or cry out; no one will hear his voice in the streets. A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out, till he leads justice to victory. In his name the nations will put their hope.'"

28.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 6:9, 10:

"He said, 'Go and tell this people: "'Be ever hearing, but never understanding; be ever seeing, but never perceiving.' Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed.'"

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 13:10-15:

"The disciples came to him and asked, 'Why do you speak to the people in parables?' He replied, 'The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. Whoever has will be given more, and he will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken from him. This is why I speak to them in parables: 'Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand.' In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: 'You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.'"

29.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 78:2:

"I will open my mouth in parables, I will utter hidden things, things from of old-"

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 13:34, 35:

"Jesus spoke all these things to the crowd in parables; he did not say anything to them without using a parable. So was fulfilled what was spoken through the prophet: 'I will open my mouth in parables, I will utter things hidden since the creation of the world.'"

30.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 20:12;

"Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you."

31.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 21:17:

"Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death."

32.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 5:16:

"Honor you father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, so that you may live long and that it may go well with you in the land the Lord your God is giving you."

33.) PROPHECY:

LEVITICUS 20:9:

"If anyone curses his father or mother, he must be put to death. He has cursed his father or his mother, and his blood will be on his own head."

34.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 29:13, 14:

"The Lord says: 'These people come near to me with their mouth and honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. Their worship of me is made up only of rules taught by men. Therefore once more I will astound these people with wonder upon wonder; the wisdom of the wise will perish, the intelligence of the intelligent will vanish.'"

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 15:1-9:

Then some of the Pharisees and teachers of the law came to Jesus from Jerusalem and asked, 'Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? They don't wash their hands before they eat!' Jesus replied, 'And why do you break the command of God for the sake of your tradition? For God said, 'Honor your father

and mother' and 'Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death. 'But you say that if a man says to his father or mother, 'Whatever help you might otherwise have received from me is a gift devoted to God,' he is not to honor his father' with it. Thus you nullify the word of God for the sake of your tradition. You hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you: 'These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are but rules taught by men.'"

35.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 19:15:

"One witness is not enough to convict a man accused of any crime or offense he may have committed. A matter must be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 18:15, 16:

"If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over. But if he will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.'"

36.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 1:27:

"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them."

37.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 2:24:

"For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 19:3-6:

"Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, 'Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?' 'Haven't you read,' he replied, 'that at the beginning the Creator "made them male and female," and said, 'For this reason

a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'? So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate."

38.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 20:12-16:

"Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you. 'You shall not murder.' 'You shall not commit adultery.' 'You shall not steal.' 'You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.'"

39.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 5:16-20:

"Honor your father and your mother, as the LORD your God has commanded you, so that you may live long and that it may go well with you in the land the LORD your God is giving you. "You shall not murder." "You shall not commit adultery." "You shall not steal." "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor."

40.) PROPHECY:

LEVITICUS 19:18:

'Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against one of your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord.'

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 19:16-19:

"Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, 'Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?' 'Why do you ask me about what is good?' Jesus replied. 'There is only One who is good. If you want to enter life, obey the commandments.' 'Which ones?' the man inquired. Jesus replied, 'Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, honor your father and mother,' and 'love your neighbor as yourself.'"

41.) PROPHECY:

ZECHARIAH 9:9:

"Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 21:1-5:

"As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethpage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, 'Go to the village ahead of you, and at once you will find a donkey tied there, with her colt by her. Untie them and bring them to me. If anyone says anything to you, tell him that the Lord needs them, and he will send them right away.' This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: 'Say to the Daughter of Zion, See, your king comes to you, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.'"

42.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 118:26:

"Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. From the house of the Lord we bless you."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 21:9:

"The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, 'Hosanna to the Son of David!' 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!' 'Hosanna in the highest!'"

43.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 56:6, 7:

"And foreigners who bind themselves to the Lord to serve him, to love the name of the Lord, and to worship him, all who keep the Sabbath without desecrating it and who hold fast to my covenant-these I will bring to my holy mountain and give them joy in my house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house will be called a house of prayer for all nations."

44.) PROPHECY:

JEREMIAH 7:11:

"Has this house, which bears my Name, become a den of robbers to you? But I have been watching! declares the Lord."

45.) PROPHECY:

MALACHI 3:1:

"See, I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come, says the LORD Almighty."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 21:12, 13:

"Jesus entered the temple area and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. 'It is written,' he said to them, 'My house will be called a house of prayer,' but you are making it a 'den of robbers.'"

46.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 8:1, 2:

"O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens. From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 21:14-16:

"The blind and the lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them. But when the chief priests and the teachers of the law saw the wonderful things he did and the children shouting in the temple area, 'Hosanna to the Son of David,' they were indignant. 'Do you hear what these children are saying?' they asked him. 'Yes,' replied Jesus, 'have you never read, 'From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise.'? "

47.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 118:22, 24:

"The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes. This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 21:42-44:

"Jesus said to them, 'Have you never read in the Scriptures': 'The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes.' 'Therefore I tell you that the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit. He who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces, but he on whom it falls will be crushed.'"

48.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 3:6:

"Then he said, 'I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob.' At this, Moses hid his face, because he was afraid to look at God.'"

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 22:30-32:

"At the resurrection people will neither marry nor be given in marriage; they will be like the angels in heaven. But about the resurrection of the dead-have you not read what God said to you, 'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? He is not the God of the dead but of the living."

49.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 6:5:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength."

50.) PROPHECY:

LEVITICUS 19:18:

"Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against one of your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 22:34-40:

"Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: 'Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?' Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

51.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 110:1:

"The Lord says to my Lord: 'Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet.'"

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 22:41-45:

"While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, 'What do you think about the Christ? Whose son is he?' 'The son of David,' they replied. He said to them, 'How is it then that David, speaking by the Spirit, calls him 'Lord'? For he says, "The Lord said to my Lord: 'Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet.'" "If then David calls him 'Lord,' how can he be his son?"

52.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 118:26:

"Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. From the house of the Lord we bless you."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 23:39:

"For I tell you, you will not see me again until you say, 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.'"

53.) PROPHECY:

ZECHARIAH 11:12:

I told them, "If you think it best, give me pay; but if not, keep it." So they paid me thirty pieces of silver."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 26:15:

"and asked, "What are you willing to give me if I hand him over to you?" So they counted out for him thirty silver coins."

54.) PROPHECY:

ZECHARIAH 13:7:

"Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, against the man who is close to me!" declares the Lord Almighty. "Strike the shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered, and I will turn my hand against the little ones."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW: 26:31-35, 55, 56:

"Jesus told them, 'This very night you will all fall away on account of me, for it is written: "I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered." But after I have risen, I will go ahead of you into Galilee.' Peter replied, 'Even if all fall away on account of you, I never will.' 'I tell you the truth,' Jesus answered, 'this very night, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times.' But Peter declared, 'Even if I have to die with you, I will never disown you.' and all the other disciples said the same."

At that time Jesus said to the crowd, 'Am I leading a rebellion, that you have come out with swords and clubs to capture me? Every day I sat in the temple courts teaching, and you did not arrest me. But this has all taken place that the writings of the prophets might be fulfilled.' Then all the disciples deserted Him and fled."

55.) PROPHECY:

ZECHARIAH 11:12, 13:

"I told them, 'If you think it best, give me pay; but if not, keep it.' So they paid me thirty pieces of silver. And the Lord said to me, 'Throw it to the potter'-the handsome price at which they priced me! So I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw them into the house of the Lord to the potter."

56.) PROPHECY:

JEREMIAH 19:1-13:

"This is what the Lord says: 'Go and buy a clay jar from a potter. Take along some of the elders of the people and of the priests and go out to the Valley of Ben Hinnom, near the entrance of the Potsherd Gate. There proclaim the words I tell you, and say, 'Hear the word of the Lord, O kings of Judah and people of Jerusalem. This is what the Lord Almighty, the God of Israel, says: Listen! I am going to bring a disaster on this place that will make the ears of everyone who hears of it tingle. For they have forsaken me and made this a place of foreign gods; they have burned sacrifices in it to gods that neither they nor their fathers nor the kings of Judah ever knew, and they have filled this place with the blood of the innocent. They have built the high places of Baal-something I did not command or mention, nor did it enter my mind. So beware, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when people will no longer call this place Topheth or the Valley of Ben Hinnom, but the Valley of Slaughter.' 'In this place I will ruin the plans of Judah and Jerusalem. I will make them fall by the sword before their enemies, at the hands of those who seek their lives.' 'Then break the jar while those who go with you are watching, and say to them, 'This is what the Lord Almighty says: I will smash this nation and this city just as this potter's jar is smashed and cannot be repaired. They will bury the dead in Topheth until there is no more room. This is what I will do to this place and to those who live here, declares the Lord. I will make this city like Topheth. The houses in Jerusalem and those of the kings of Judah will be defiled like this place, Topheth-all the houses where they burned incense on the roofs to all the starry hosts and poured out drink offerings to other gods.'"

57.) PROPHECY:

JEREMIAH 32:6-9:

"Jeremiah said, 'The word of the Lord came to me: Hanamel son of Shallum your uncle is going to come to you and say, 'Buy my field at Anathoth, because as nearest relative it is your right and duty to buy it.' Then, just as the Lord had said, my cousin Hanamel came to me in the courtyard of the guard and said, 'Buy my

field at Anathoth in the territory of Benjamin. Since it is your right to redeem it and possess it, buy it for yourself.' I knew that this was the word of the Lord; so I bought the field at Anathoth from my cousin Hanamel and weighed out for him seventeen shekels of silver."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 27:5-10

"So Judas threw the money into the temple and left. Then he went away and hanged himself. The chief priests picked up the coins and said, 'It is against the law to put this into the treasury, since it is blood money.' So they decided to use the money to buy the potter's field as a burial place for foreigners. That is why it has been called the Field of Blood to this day. Then what was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled: 'They took the thirty silver coins, the price set on him by the people of Israel, and they used them to buy the potter's field, as the Lord commanded me.'"

58.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:8, 9:

"By oppression and judgment he was taken away. And who can speak of his descendants? For he was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgression of my people he was stricken. He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 27:31-60:

"After they had mocked him, they took off the robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him away to crucify him. As they were going out, they met a man from Cyrene, named Simon, and they forced him to carry the cross. They came to a place called Golgotha (which means the place of the Skull.) There they offered Jesus wine to drink, mixed with gall; but after tasting it, he refused to drink it. When they had crucified him, they divided up his clothes by casting lots. And sitting down, they kept watch over him there. Above his head they placed the written charge against him: THIS IS JESUS, THE KING OF THE JEWS. Two robbers were crucified with him, one on his right and one on his left. Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself! He's the King of Israel! Let him come down now from the

cross, and we will believe him. He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, "I am the Son of God." In the same way the robbers who were crucified with him also heaped insults on him. From the sixth hour until the ninth hour darkness came over all the land. About the ninth hour Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachtani?" which means, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" When some of those standing there heard this, they said, "He's calling Elijah." Immediately one of them ran and got a sponge. He filled it with wine vinegar, put it on a stick, and offered it to Jesus to drink. The rest said, "Now leave him alone. Let's see if Elijah comes to save him." And when Jesus had cried out again in a loud voice, he gave up his spirit. At that moment the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook and the rocks split. The tombs broke open and the bodies of many holy people who had died were raised to life. They came out of the tombs, and after Jesus' resurrection they went into the holy city and appeared to many people. When the centurion and those with him who were guarding Jesus saw the earthquake and all that happened, they were terrified, and exclaimed, "Surely he was the Son of God!" Many women were there, watching from a distance. They had followed Jesus from Galilee to care for his needs. Among them were Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James and Joseph, and the mother of Zebedee's sons. As evening approached, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him. Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away.

59.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 69:22

"May the table set before them become a snare; may it become retribution and a trap."

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 27:34:

"There they offered Jesus wine to drink, mixed with gall; but after tasting it, he refused to drink it."

60.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 22:18:

"They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing"

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 27:35:

“When they had crucified him, they divided up his clothes by casting lots.”

61.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 22: 6-8:

“But I am a worm and a not a man, scorned by men and despised by the people. All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads: “He trusts in the LORD; let the LORD rescue him, since he delights in him.”

FULFILLMENT:

MATTHEW 27: 39-44:

“Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads and saying, “You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!” In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. “He saved others,” they said, “but he can’t save himself! FULFILLMENT:

JOHN 12:37, 38:

"Even after Jesus had done all these miraculous signs in their presence, they still would not believe in him. This was to fulfill the word of Isaiah the prophet: 'Lord, who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?'"

138.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 6:10:

"Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed."

FULFILLMENT:

JOHN 12:39, 40:

"For this reason they could not believe, because, as Isaiah says elsewhere: 'He has blinded their eyes and deadened their hearts, so they can neither see with their eyes, nor understand with their hearts, nor turn-and I would heal them.'"

139.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 41:9:

"Even my close friend, whom I trusted, he who shared my bread, has lifted up his heel against me."

FULFILLMENT:

JOHN 13:18:

“I am not referring to all of you; I know those I have chosen. But this is to fulfill the scripture: 'He who shares my bread has lifted up his heel against me.'”

"Let not those gloat over me who are my enemies without cause; let not those who hate me without reason maliciously wink the eye."

Yet it was the LORD's will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the LORD makes his life a guilt offering, he will see his offspring and prolong his days, and the will of the LORD will prolong in his hand. After the suffering of his soul, he will see the light [of life] and be satisfied; by his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities. Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death,

and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.”

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 3:13-18:

“The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus. You handed him over to be killed, and you disowned him before Pilate, though he had decided to let him go. You disowned the Holy and Righteous One and asked that a murderer be released to you. You killed the author of life, but God raised him from the dead. We are witnesses of this. By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus’ name and the faith that comes through him that has given this complete healing to him, as you can all see. “Now, brothers, I know that you acted in ignorance, as did your leaders. "The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes."

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 4:8-12:

"Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them: 'Rulers and elders of the people! If we are being called to account today for an act of kindness shown to a cripple and are asked how he was healed, then know this, you and all the people of Israel: It is by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed. He is "'the stone the builders rejected, which has become the capstone.' Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved."

158.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 2:1, 2:

"Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the Lord and against his Anointed One."

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 4:23-26:

"On their release, Peter and John went back to their own people and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said to them. When they heard this, they raised their voices together in prayer to God. 'Sovereign Lord,' they said, 'You made the heaven and the earth and the sea, and everything in them. You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of your servant, our father David: "'Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the Lord and against his Anointed One.'"

159.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 18:15

"The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own brothers. You must listen to him."

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 7:35-37:

"This is the same Moses whom they had rejected with the words, 'Who made you ruler and judge?' He was sent to be their ruler and deliverer by God himself, through the angel who appeared to him in the bush. He led them out of Egypt and did wonders and miraculous signs in Egypt, at the Red Sea and for forty years in the desert. "This is that Moses who told the Israelites, 'God will send you a prophet like me from your own people.'"

160.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 66:1, 2:

"This is what the Lord says: 'Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where will my resting place be? Has not my hand made all these things, and so they came into being?' declares the Lord. 'This is the one I esteem: he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and trembles at my word.'"

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 7:48-53:

"However, the Most High does not live in houses made by men. As the prophet says: 'Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. What kind of house will you build For me?' says the Lord. 'Or where will my resting place be? Has not my

hand made all these things?" "You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always resist the Holy Spirit! Was there ever a prophet your fathers did not persecute? They even killed those who predicted the coming of the Righteous One. And now you have betrayed and murdered him—you who have received the law that was put into effect through angels but have not obeyed it."

161.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:7, 8:

"He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth. By oppression and judgment he was taken away. And who can speak of his descendants? For he was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgression of my people he was stricken."

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS: 8:30-35:

"Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. 'Do you understand what you are reading?' Philip asked. 'How can I,' he said, 'unless someone explains it to me?' So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him. The eunuch was reading this passage of scripture: 'He was led like a sheep to the slaughter, and as a lamb before the shearer is silent, so he did not open his mouth. In his humiliation he was deprived of justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth.' The eunuch asked Philip, 'Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?' Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus."

162.) PROPHECY:

But God raised him from the dead, and for many days he was seen by those who had traveled with him from Galilee to Jerusalem. They are now his witnesses to our people. "We tell you the good news: What God promised our fathers he has fulfilled for us, their children, by raising up Jesus. "Give ear and come to me; hear me, that your soul may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David."

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 13:32-35:

"We tell you the good news: What God promised our fathers he has fulfilled for us, their children, by raising up Jesus. As it is written in the second Psalm: "'You are my Son; today I have become your Father.' The fact that God raised him from the dead, never to decay, is stated in these words: "'I will give you the holy and sure blessings promised to David.' So it is stated elsewhere: "'You will not let your Holy One see decay.'"

167.) PROPHECY:

HABAKKUK: 1:5:

"Look at the nations and watch-and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe, even if you were told."

168.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:11:

"After the suffering of his soul, he will see the light [of life] and be satisfied; by his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities."

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 13:38-41:

"Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you. Through him everyone who believes is justified from everything you could not be justified from by the law of Moses. Take care that what the prophets have said does not happen to you: "Look you scoffers, wonder and perish, for I am going to do something in your days that you would never believe, even if someone told you."

169.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 49:6:

"This is what the Lord says: 'In the time of my favor I will answer you, and in the day of salvation I will help you; I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people, to restore the land and to reassign its desolate inheritances,'"

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 13:46-48:

"Then Paul and Barnabas answered them boldly: 'We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life, we now turn to the Gentiles. For this is what the Lord has commanded us: "I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.'" "This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the Christ," he said. Some of the Jews were persuaded and joined Paul and Silas, as did a large number of God-fearing Greeks and not a few prominent women."

172.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 6:9, 10:

"He said, 'Go and tell this people: "'Be ever hearing, but never understanding; be ever seeing, but never perceiving.' Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed.'"

FULFILLMENT:

ACTS 28:23-29:

"They arranged to meet Paul on a certain day, and came in even larger numbers to the place where he was staying. From morning till evening he explained and declared to them the kingdom of God and tried to convince them about Jesus from the Law of Moses and from the Prophets. Some were convinced by what he said, but others would not believe. They disagreed among themselves and began to leave after Paul had made this final statement: "The Holy Spirit spoke the truth to your forefathers when he said through Isaiah the prophet: "'Go to this people and say, "You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving." For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would

heal them.' Therefore I want you to know that God's salvation has been sent to the Gentiles, and they will listen."

ROMANS

174.) PROPHECY:

HABAKKUK 2:4:

"See, he is puffed up; his desires are not upright-but the righteous will live by his faith-"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 1:16-17:

"I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: 'The righteous will live by faith.'"

175.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 62:11, 12:

"One thing God has spoken, two things have I heard: that you, O God, are strong, and that you, O Lord, are loving. Surely you will reward each person according to what he has done."

176.) PROPHECY:

PROVERBS 24:11, 12:

"Rescue those being led away to death; hold back those staggering toward slaughter. If you say, 'But we knew nothing about this,' does not he who weighs the heart perceive it? Does not he who guards your life know it? Will he not repay each person according to what he has done?"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 2:5, 6, 16:

"But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath against yourself for the day of God's wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed.

God 'will give to each person according to what he has done.' "This will take place on the day when God will judge men's secrets through Jesus Christ, as my gospel declares."

177.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 52:5:

"And now what do I have here?" declares the Lord. "For my people have been taken away for nothing, and those who rule them mock," declares the Lord. "And all day long my name is constantly blasphemed."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 2:21-24:

"you, then, who teach others, do you not teach yourself? You who preach against stealing, do you steal? You who say that people should not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? You who brag about the law, do you dishonor God by breaking the law? As it is written: 'God's name is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you.'"

178.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 51:1-4:

"Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 3:3, 4:

"What if someone did not have faith? Will their lack of faith nullify God's faithfulness? Not at all! Let God be true, and every man a liar. As it is written: 'So that you may be proved right when you speak and prevail when you judge.'"

179.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 14:1-3:

"The fool says in his heart, 'There is no God.' They are corrupt, their deeds are vile; there is no one who does good. The Lord looks down from heaven on the sons of men to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God. All have

turned aside, they have together become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one."

180.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 53:1-3:

"The fool says in his heart, 'There is no God.' They are corrupt, and their ways are vile; there is no one who does good. God looks down from heaven on the sons of men to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God. Everyone has turned away, they have together become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one."

181.) PROPHECY:

ECCLESIASTES 7:20:

"There is not a righteous man on earth who does what is right and never sins."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 3:9-12:

"What shall we conclude then? Are we any better? Not at all! We have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are all under sin. As it is written: 'There is no one righteous, not even one; there is no one who understands, no one who seeks God. All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one.'"

182.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 5:9:

"Not a word from their mouth can be trusted; their heart is filled with destruction. Their throat is an open grave; with their tongue they speak deceit."

183.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 140:3:

"They make their tongues as sharp as a serpent's; the poison of vipers is on their lips."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 3:13:

"Their throats are open graves; their tongues practice deceit." "The poison of vipers is on their lips."

184.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 10:7:

"His mouth is full of curses and lies and threats; trouble and evil are under his tongue."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 3:14:

"Their mouths are full of cursing and bitterness."

185.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 59:7, 8:

"Their feet rush into sin; they are swift to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are evil thoughts; ruin and destruction mark their ways. The way of peace they do not know; there is no justice in their paths. They have turned them into crooked roads; no one who walks in them will know peace."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 3:15-17:

"Their feet are swift to shed blood; ruin and misery mark their ways, and the way of peace they do not know."

186.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 36:1:

"An oracle is within my heart concerning the sinfulness of the wicked."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 3:18:

"There is no fear of God before their eyes."

187.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:11:

"After the suffering of his soul, he will see the light [of life] and be satisfied; by his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 3:19-31:

"Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world held accountable to God. Therefore no one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of sin. But now a righteousness from God, apart from the law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished—he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus. Where then, is boasting? It is excluded. On what principle? On that of observing the law? No, but on that of faith. For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from observing the law. Is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles too? Yes, of Gentiles too, since there is only one God, who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through that same faith."

188.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 15:4-6:

"Then the word of the Lord came to him: 'This man will not be an heir, but a son coming from your own body will be your heir.' He took him outside and said, 'Look up at the heavens and count the stars—if indeed you can count them.' Then he said to him, 'So shall your offspring be.' Abram believed the Lord, and he credited it to him as righteousness."

189.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 17:4, 5:

"As for me, this is my covenant with you: You will be the father of many nations. No longer will you be called Abram; your name will be Abraham, for I have made you a father of many nations."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 4:3-8:

"What does the Scripture say? 'Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.' Now when a man works, his wages are not credited to him as a gift, but as an obligation. However, to the man who does not work but trusts God who justifies the wicked, his faith is credited as righteousness. David says the same thing when he speaks of the blessedness of the man to whom God credits righteousness apart from works: 'Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man whose sin the Lord will never count against him.'"

190.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:6:

"We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 5:6-8:

"You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

191.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 20:17:

"You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

192.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 5:21:

"You shall not covet your neighbor's wife. You shall not set your desire on your neighbor's house or land, his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 7:7, 8, 24, 25:

"What shall we say, then? Is the law sin? Certainly not! Indeed I would not have known what sin was except through the law. For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, 'Do not covet.' But sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, produced in me every kind of covetous desire. For apart from law, sin is dead."

193.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 44:22:

"Yet for your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 8:28-30; 34-36:

"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified, he also glorified."

"Who is it that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered."

194.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 18:10, 14:

"Then the Lord said, 'I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah your wife will have a son.'"

"Is anything too hard for the Lord? I will return to you at the appointed time next year and Sarah will have a son."

195.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 21:12:

"But God said to him, 'Do not be so distressed about the boy and your maidservant. Listen to whatever Sarah tells you, because it is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned.'"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:1-9:

"I speak the truth in Christ-I am not lying, my conscience confirms it in the Holy Spirit-I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were cursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, those of my own race, the people of Israel. Theirs is the adoption as sons; theirs the divine glory, the covenants, the receiving of the law, the temple worship and the promises. Theirs are the patriarchs, and from them is traced the human ancestry of Christ, who is God over all, forever praised! Amen. It is not as though God's word had failed. For not all who are descended from Israel are Israel. Nor because they are his descendants are they all Abraham's children. On the contrary, 'It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned.' In other words, it is not the natural children who are God's children, but it is the children of the promise who are regarded as Abraham's offspring. For this is how the promise was stated: 'At the appointed time I will return, and Sarah will have a son.'"

196.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 25:21-24:

"Isaac prayed to the Lord on behalf of his wife, because she was barren. The Lord answered his prayer, and his wife Rebekah became pregnant. The babies jostled each other within her, and she said, 'Why is this happening to me?' So she went to inquire of the Lord. "The Lord said to her, 'Two nations are in your womb, and two peoples from within you will be separated; one people will be stronger than the other, and the older will serve the younger.'"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:9-12:

"For this was how the promise was stated: 'At the appointed time I will return, and Sarah will have a son.' Not only that, but Rebekah's children had one and the same father, our father Isaac. Yet, before the twins were born or had done anything good or bad-in order that God's purpose in election might stand: not by works but by him who calls-she was told, 'The older will serve the younger.'"

197.) PROPHECY:

MALACHI 1:2, 3:

"I have loved you," says the Lord. "But you ask, 'How have you loved us?' "Was not Esau Jacob's brother?" the Lord says. "Yet I have loved Jacob, but Esau I have hated, and I have turned his mountains into a wasteland and left his inheritance to the desert jackals."

198.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 33:19:

"And the Lord said, 'I will cause all my goodness to pass in front of you, and I will proclaim my name, the Lord, in your presence. I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.'"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:13-15:

"Just as it is written: 'Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated.' What then shall we say? Is God unjust? Not at all! For he says to Moses, 'I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion.'"

199.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 9:16:

"But I have raised you up for this very purpose, that I might show you my power and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:16-18:

"It does not, therefore, depend on man's desire or effort, but on God's mercy. For the Scripture says to Pharaoh: 'I raised you up for this very purpose, that I might display my power in you and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth. Therefore God has mercy on whom he wants to have mercy, and he hardens whom he wants to harden.'"

200.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 29:16:

"You turn things upside down, as if the potter were thought to be like the clay! Shall what is formed say to him who formed it, 'He did not make me'? Can the pot say of the potter, 'He knows nothing'?"

201.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 45:9:

"Woe to him who quarrels with his Maker, to him who is but a potsherd among the potsherds on the ground. Does the clay say to the potter, 'What are you making?' Does your work say, 'He has no hands'?"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:19-21:

"One of you will say to me: 'Then why does God still blame us? For who resists his will?' But who are you, O man, to talk back to God? 'Shall what is formed say to him who formed it, 'Why did you make me like this?'" Does not the potter have the right to make out of the same lump of clay some pottery for noble purposes and some for common use?"

202.) PROPHECY:

HOSEA 2:23:

"I will plant her for myself in the land; I will show my love to the one I called 'Not my loved one.' I will say to those called 'Not my people,' 'You are my people'; and they will say, 'You are my God.'"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:22-25:

"What if God, choosing to show his wrath and make his power known, bore with great patience the objects of his wrath-prepared for destruction? What if he did this to make the riches of his glory known to the objects of his mercy, whom he prepared in advance for glory-even us, whom he also called, not only from the Jews but also from the Gentiles? As he says in Hosea: "I will call them 'my people' who are not my people; and I will call her 'my loved one' who is not my loved one,"

203.) PROPHECY:

HOSEA 1:10, 11:

"Yet the Israelites will be like the sands on the seashore, which cannot be measured or counted. In the place where it was said to them, 'You are not my people,' they will be called 'sons of the living God.'"

204.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 1:9:

"Unless the Lord Almighty had left us some survivors, we would have become like Sodom, we would have been like Gomorrah."

205.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 10:22, 23:

"Though your people, O Israel, be like the sand by the sea, only a remnant will return. Destruction has been decreed, overwhelming and righteous. The Lord, the Lord Almighty, will carry out the destruction decreed upon the whole land."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:26-29:

"It will happen that in the very place where it was said to them, 'You are not my people,' they will be called 'sons of the living God.' Isaiah cries out concerning Israel: "Though the number of the Israelites be like the sand by the sea, only the remnant will be saved. For the Lord will carry out his sentence on earth with speed and finality." It is just as Isaiah said previously: "Unless the Lord Almighty had left us descendants, we would have become like Sodom, we would have been like Gomorrah."

206.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 8:14:

"and he will be a sanctuary; but for both houses of Israel he will be a stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall. And for the people of Jerusalem he will be a trap and a snare."

207.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 28:16:

"So this is what the Sovereign Lord says: 'See, I lay a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; the one who trusts will never be dismayed.'"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 9:30-33:

"What then shall we say? That the Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have obtained it, a righteousness that is by faith; but Israel, who pursued a law of righteousness, has not attained it. Why not? Because they pursued it not by faith but as if it were by works. They stumbled over the 'stumbling stone.' As it is written: 'See, I lay in Zion a stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame.'"

208.) PROPHECY:

LEVITICUS 18:5:

"Keep my decrees and laws, for the man who obeys them will live by them. I am the Lord"

209.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 30:12-14:

"It is not up in heaven, so that you have to ask, 'Who will ascend into heaven to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?' Nor is it beyond the sea, so that you have to ask, 'Who will cross the sea to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?' No, the word is very near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart so you may obey it."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 10:4-10:

"Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes. Moses describes in this way the righteousness that is by the law: 'The man who does these things will live by them.' But the righteousness that is by faith says: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down) "or 'Who will descend into the deep?'" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the word of faith we are proclaiming: That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved."

210.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 28:16:

"So this is what the Sovereign Lord says: 'See, I lay a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; the one who trusts will never be dismayed.'"

211.) PROPHECY:

JOEL 2:32:

"And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved; for on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there will be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the survivors whom the Lord calls."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 10:11-13:

"As the Scripture says, 'Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame.' For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile-the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, for, 'Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'"

212.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 52:7:

"How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, 'Your God reigns!'"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 10:14, 15:

"How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, 'How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!'"

213.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:1:

"Who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?"

214.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 19:4:

"Their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 10:16-18:

"But not all the Israelites accepted the good news. For Isaiah says, 'Lord, who has believed our message?' Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ. But I ask: did they not hear? Of course they did: "Their voice has gone out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world.'"

215.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 32:21:

"They made me jealous by what is no god and angered me with their worthless idols. I will make them envious by those who are not a people; I will make them angry by a nation that has no understanding."

216.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 65:1, 2:

"I revealed myself to those who did not ask for me; I was found by those who did not seek me. To a nation that did not call on my name, I said, 'Here am I, here am I.' All day long I have held out my hands to an obstinate people, who walk in ways not good, pursuing their own imaginations-"

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 10:19-21:

"Again I ask: Did Israel not understand? First, Moses says, 'I will make you envious by those who are not a nation; I will make you angry by a nation that has no understanding.' And Isaiah boldly says, 'I was found by those who did not seek me; I revealed myself to those who did not ask for me.' But concerning Israel he says, 'All day long I have held out my hands to a disobedient and obstinate people.'"

217.) PROPHECY:

I KINGS 19:10, 14, 18:

"And the word of the Lord came to him: 'What are you doing here, Elijah?' He replied, 'I have been very zealous for the Lord God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, broken down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too.'"

"He replied, 'I have been very zealous for the Lord God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, broken down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too.'"

And what was God's answer to him? 'I have reserved for myself seven thousand who have not bowed the knee to Baal.' So too, at the present time there is a remnant chosen by grace. And if by grace, then it is no longer by works; if it were, grace would no longer be grace."

218.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 29:4:

"But to this day the Lord has not given you a mind that understands or eyes that see or ears that hear."

219.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 29:10:

"The Lord has brought over you a deep sleep: He has sealed your eyes (the prophets); he has covered your heads (the seers)."

220.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 69:22, 23:

"May the table set before them become a snare; may it become retribution and a trap. May their eyes be darkened so they cannot see, and their backs be bent forever."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 11:7-10:

"What then? What Israel sought so earnestly it did not obtain, but the elect did. The others were hardened, as it is written: 'God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes so that they could not see and ears so that they could not hear, to this very day.' And David says: 'May their table become a snare and a trap, a stumbling block and a retribution for them. May their eyes be darkened so they cannot see, and their backs be bent forever.'"

221.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 59:20, 21:

“The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who repent of their sins,” declares the Lord.

222.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 27:9:

"As for me, this is my covenant with them," says the Lord. "My Spirit, who is on you, and my words that I have put in your mouth will not depart from your mouth, or from the mouths of your children, or from the mouths of their descendants from this time on and forever," says the Lord."

223.) PROPHECY:

JEREMIAH 31:33, 34:

"This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time," declares the Lord. "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the Lord. "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 11:25-27:

"I do not want you to be ignorant of this mystery, brothers, so that you may not be conceited: Israel has experienced a hardening in part until the full number of the Gentiles has come in. And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: 'The deliverer will come from Zion; he will turn godlessness away from Jacob. And this is my covenant with them when I take away their sins.'"

224.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 40:13, 14:

"Who has understood the mind of the Lord, or instructed him as his counselor? Whom did the Lord consult to enlighten him, and who taught him the right way? Who was it that taught him knowledge or showed him the path of understanding?"

225.) PROPHECY:

JOB 41:11:

"Who has a claim against me that I must pay? Everything under heaven belongs to me."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 11:33-36:

"Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out! "Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?" "Who has ever given to God, that God should repay him?" For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen."

226.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 32:35:

"It is mine to avenge; I will repay. In due time their foot will slip; their day of disaster is near and their doom rushes upon them."

227.) PROPHECY:

PROVERBS 25:21, 22:

"If your enemy is hungry, give him food to eat; if he is thirsty, give him water to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head, and the Lord will reward you."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 12:18-21:

"If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: 'It is mine to avenge; I will repay,' says the Lord. On the contrary: 'If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head.'"

228.) PROPHECY:

EXODUS 20:13-15, 17:

"You shall not murder." "You shall not commit adultery." "You shall not steal."
"You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

229.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 5:17-19, 21:

"You shall not murder." "You shall not commit adultery." "You shall not steal."
"You shall not covet your neighbor's wife. You shall not set your desire on your neighbor's house or land, his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

230.) PROPHECY:

LEVITICUS 19:18:

"Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against one of your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 13:8-10:

"Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for he who loves his fellow-man has fulfilled the law. The commandments, 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not covet,' and whatever other commandment there may be, are summed up in this one rule: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' Love does no harm to its neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law."

231.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 45:23:

"By myself I have sworn, my mouth has uttered in all integrity a word that will not be revoked: Before me every knee will bow; by me every tongue will swear."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 14:8-12:

"If we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord. For this very reason, Christ died and returned to life so that he might be the Lord of both the dead and the living. You, then, why do you judge your brother? Or why do you look down on your brother? For we will all stand before God's judgment seat. It is written: 'As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will confess to God.' So then, each of us will give an account of himself to God."

232.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 69:9:

"for zeal for your house consumes me, and the insults of those who insult you fall on me."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 15:2-4:

"Each of us should please his neighbor for his good, to build him up. For even Christ did not please himself but, as it is written: 'The insults of those who insult you have fallen on me.' For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope."

233.) PROPHECY:

II SAMUEL 22:50:

"Therefore I will praise you, O Lord, among the nations; I will sing praises to your name."

234.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 18:49:

"Therefore I will praise you among the nations, O Lord; I will sing praises to your name."

235.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 32:43:

"Rejoice, O nations, with his people, for he will avenge the blood of his servants; he will take vengeance on his enemies and make atonement for his land and people."

236.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 117:1:

"Praise the Lord, all you nations; extol him, all you peoples."

237.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 11:10:

"In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 15:7-12:

"Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God. For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's truth, to confirm the promises made to the patriarchs so that the Gentiles may glorify God for his mercy, as it is written: "Therefore I will praise you among the Gentiles; I will sing hymns to your name." Again it says, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with his people." And again, "Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and sing praises to him, all you peoples." And again, Isaiah says, "The Root of Jesse will spring up, one who will arise to rule over the nations; the Gentiles will hope in him."

238.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 52:15:

"so will he sprinkle many nations, and kings will shut their mouths because of him. For what they were not told, they will see, and what they have not heard, they will understand."

FULFILLMENT:

ROMANS 15:20, 21:

“It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else's foundation. Rather, as it is written: 'Those who were not told about him will see, and those who have not heard will understand.'”

THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHECY

I CORINTHIANS

239.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 29:14:

"Therefore once more I will astound these people with wonder upon wonder; the wisdom of the wise will perish, the intelligence of the intelligent will vanish."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 1:18, 19, 25.

"For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written: 'I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; the intelligence of the intelligent I will frustrate.'

"For the foolishness of God is wiser than man's wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than man's strength."

240.) PROPHECY:

JEREMIAH 9:24:

"but let him who boasts boast about this: that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord, who exercises kindness, justice and righteousness on earth, for in these I delight,' declares the Lord."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 1:30, 31:

"It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God-that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption. Therefore, as it is written: 'Let him who boasts boast in the Lord.'"

241.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 64:4:

"Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 2:7-10:

"No, we speak of God's secret wisdom, a wisdom that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began. None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. However, as it is written: 'No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him.'-but God revealed it to us by his Spirit."

242.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 40:13:

"Who has understood the mind of the Lord, or instructed him as his counselor? Whom did the Lord consult to enlighten him, and who taught him the right way? Who was it that taught him knowledge or showed him the path of understanding?"

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 2:14-16:

"The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned. The spiritual man makes judgments about all things, but he himself is not subject to any man's judgment: 'For who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct him?' But we have the mind of Christ."

243.) PROPHECY:

JOB 5:13:

"He catches the wise in their craftiness, and the schemes of the wily are swept away."

244.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 94:11:

"The Lord knows the thoughts of man; he knows that they are futile."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 3:18-23:

"Do not deceive yourselves. If any one of you thinks he is wise by the standards of this age, he should become a 'fool' so that he may become wise. For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in God's sight. As it is written: 'He catches the wise in their craftiness', and again, 'The Lord knows that the thoughts of the wise are futile.' So then, no more boasting about men! All things are yours, whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or the present or the future—all are yours, and you are of Christ, and Christ is of God."

245.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 17:7:

"The hands of the witnesses must be the first in putting him to death, and then the hands of all the people. You must purge the evil from among you."

246.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 19:18-21:

"The judges must make a thorough investigation, and if the witness proves to be a liar, giving false testimony against his brother, then do to him as he intended to do to his brother. You must purge the evil from among you. The rest of the people will hear of this and be afraid, and never again will such an evil thing be done among you. Show no pity: life for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot."

247.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 21:21:

"Then all the men of his town shall stone him to death. You must purge the evil from among you. All Israel will hear of it and be afraid."

248.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 22:20-24:

"If, however, the charge is true and no proof of the girl's virginity can be found, she shall be brought to the door of her father's house and there the men of her town shall stone her to death. She has done a disgraceful thing in Israel by being promiscuous while still in her father's house. You must purge the evil from among you. If a man is found sleeping with another man's wife, both the man who slept

with her and the woman must die. You must purge the evil from Israel. If a man happens to meet in a town a virgin pledged to be married and he sleeps with her, you shall take both of them to the gate of that town and stone them to death-the girl because she was in a town and did not scream for help, and the man because he violated another man's wife. You must purge the evil from among you."

249.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 24:7:

"If a man is caught kidnapping one of his brother Israelites and treats him as a slave or sells him, the kidnapper must die. You must purge the evil from among you."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 5:12-13:

"What business is it of mine to judge those outside of the church? Are you not to judge those inside? God will judge those outside. 'Expel the wicked man from among you.'"

250.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 2:24:

"For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 6:15-17:

"Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ himself? Shall I then take the members of Christ and unite them with a prostitute? Never! Do you not know that he who unites himself with a prostitute is one with her body? For it is said, 'The two will become one flesh.' But he who unites himself with the Lord is one with him in spirit."

251.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 25:4:

"Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 9:9-12:

"For it is written in the Law of Moses: 'Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain.' Is it about oxen that God is concerned? Surely he says this for us, doesn't he? Yes, this was written for us, because when the plowman plows and the thresher threshes they ought to do so in the hope of sharing in the harvest. If we have sown spiritual seed among you, is it too much if we reap a material harvest from you? If others have this right of support from you, shouldn't we have it all the more?"

252.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 24:1:

"The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;"

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 10:23-26:

"Everything is permissible'-but not everything is beneficial. "Everything is permissible" -but not everything is constructive. Nobody should seek his own good, but the good of others. Eat anything sold in the meat market without raising questions of conscience, for "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it."

253.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 28:11,12:

"Very well then, with foreign lips and strange tongues God will speak to his people, to whom he said, 'This is the resting place, let the weary rest'; and, 'This is the place of repose'-but they would not listen."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 14:21,22:

"In the Law it is written: 'Through men of strange tongues and through the lips of foreigners I will speak to this people, but even then they will not listen to me.' says the Lord. 'Tongues, then, are a sign, not for believers but for unbelievers; prophecy, however, is for believers, not for unbelievers'"

254.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 8:6:

"You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet:"

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 15:21-28:

"For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. But each in his own turn: Christ, the first-fruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him. Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death. For he 'has put everything under his feet.' Now when it says that 'everything' has been put under him, it is clear that this does not include God himself, who put everything under Christ. When he has done this, then the Son himself will be made subject to him who put everything under him, so that God may be all in all."

255.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 2:7:

"The Lord God formed the man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being."

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 15:42-46:

"So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. So it is written: 'The first man Adam became a living being'; the last Adam, a life-giving spirit. The spiritual did not come first, but the natural, and after that the spiritual."

256.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 25:8:

"he will swallow up death forever. The Sovereign Lord will wipe away the tears from all faces; he will remove the disgrace of his people from all the earth. The Lord has spoken."

257.) PROPHECY:

HOSEA 13:14:

"I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death. Where, O death, are your plagues? Where, O grave, is your destruction?"

FULFILLMENT:

I CORINTHIANS 15:53-57:

FULFILLMENT:

GALATIANS 4:28-31:

For when there is a change of the priesthood, there must also be a change of the law. He of whom these things are said belonged to a different tribe, and no one from that tribe has ever served at the altar. For it is clear that our Lord descended from Judah, and in regard to that tribe Moses said nothing about priests. And what we have said is even more clear if another priest like Melchizadek appears, one who has become a priest not on the basis of a regulation as to his ancestry but on the basis of the power of an indestructible life. For it is declared: 'You are a priest forever, in the order of Melchizadek.' The former regulation is set aside because it was weak and useless (for the law made nothing perfect), and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God. And it was not without an oath! Others became priests without any oath, but he became a priest with an oath when God said to him: "The lord has sworn and will not change his mind: 'You are a priest forever.'" "Because of this oath, Jesus has become the guarantee of a better covenant."

“The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler’s staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his.”

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 7:14:

HEBREWS 8:6-13:

"But the ministry Jesus received is as superior to theirs as the covenant of which he is mediator is superior to the old one, and it is founded on better promises. For if there had been nothing wrong with that first covenant, no place would have been sought for another. But God found fault with the people and said: 'The time is coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they did not remain faithful to my covenant, and I turned away from them,' declares the Lord. This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest. For I will forgive their

310.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:12c:

"For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 9:28:

"so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him."

311.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 40:6-8:

"Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but my ears you have pierced; burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not require. Then I said, 'Here I am, I have come-it is written about me in the scroll. I desire to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart.'"

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 10:1-7:

"The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming-not the realities themselves. For this reason it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship. If it could, would they not have stopped being offered? For the worshippers would have been cleansed once for all, and would no longer have felt guilty for their sins. But those sacrifices are an annual reminder of sins, because it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. Therefore, when Christ came into the world, he said: 'Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me; with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased. Then I said, 'Here I am-it is written about me in the scroll-I have come to do your will, O God.'"

312.) PROPHECY:

JEREMIAH 31:31-34:

"The time is coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they broke my covenant, though I was a husband to them," declares the Lord. This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time," declares the Lord. "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the Lord. "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 10:10-18:

"And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But when this priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God. Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his foot-stool, because by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy. The Holy Spirit also testifies to us about this. First he says: 'This is the covenant I will make with them after that time, says the Lord. I will put my laws in their hearts, and I will write them on their minds.' Then he adds: 'Their sins and lawless acts I will remember no more.'"

313.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 32:35, 36:

"It is mine to avenge; I will repay. In due time their foot will slip; their day of disaster is near and their doom rushes upon them.' The Lord will judge his people and have compassion on his servants when he sees their strength is gone and no one is left, slave or free."

314.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 135:14:

"For the Lord will vindicate his people and have compassion on his servants."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 10:28-31:

"Anyone who rejected the law of Moses died without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. How much more severely do you think a man deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God under foot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified him, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace? For we know him who said, 'It is mine to avenge; I will repay,' and again, 'The Lord will judge his people.' It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God."

315.) PROPHECY:

HABAKKUK 2:3,4:

"For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay. See, he is puffed up; his desires are not upright-but the righteous will live by his faith-"

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 10:35-39:

"So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. For in just a very little while, 'He who is coming will come and will not delay. But my righteous one will live by faith. And if he shrinks back, I will not be pleased with him. But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who believe and are saved."

316.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 21:12:

"But God said to him, 'Do not be so distressed about the boy and your maidservant. Listen to whatever Sarah tells you, because it is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned ."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 11:17-19:

"By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had received the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, even

though God had said to him, 'It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned.' Abraham reasoned that God could raise the dead, and figuratively speaking, he did receive Isaac back from death."

317.) PROPHECY:

PROVERBS 3:11, 12:

"My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline and do not resent his rebuke, because the Lord disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 12:4-7:

"In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that addresses you as sons: 'My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts as a son.'"

318.) PROPHECY:

PROVERBS 4:25-27:

"Let your eyes look straight ahead, fix your gaze directly before you. Make level paths for your feet and take only ways that are firm. Do not swerve to the right or the left; keep your foot from evil."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 12:11-13:

"No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it. Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. 'Make level paths for your feet,' so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed."

319.) PROPHECY:

HAGGAI 2:6, 7:

"This is what the Lord Almighty says: 'In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. I will shake all nations, and the desired of all nations will come, and I will fill this house with glory,' says the Lord Almighty."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 12:25-27:

"See to it that you do not refuse him who speaks. If they did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, how much less will we, if we turn away from him who warns us from heaven? At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, 'Once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens.' The words 'once more' indicate the removing of what can be shaken-that is, created things-so that what cannot be shaken may remain."

320.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 4:24:

"For the Lord your God is a consuming fire, a jealous God."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 12:28, 29:

"Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our 'God is a consuming fire.'"

321.) PROPHECY:

DEUTERONOMY 31:6:

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you."

322.) PROPHECY:

PSALMS 118:6, 7:

"The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me? The Lord is with me, he is my helper. I will look in triumph on my enemies."

FULFILLMENT:

HEBREWS 13:5-8:

"Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, 'Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.' So we say with confidence, 'The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man

do to me?' Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."

325.) PROPHECY:

JAMES 2:11-13:

"For he who said, 'Do not commit adultery,' also said, 'Do not murder.' If you do not commit adultery but do commit murder, you have become a lawbreaker. Speak and act as those who are going to be judged by the law that gives freedom, because judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful. Mercy triumphs over judgment!"

326.) PROPHECY:

GENESIS 15:6:

"Abram believed the Lord, and he credited it to him as righteousness.

FULFILLMENT:

JAMES 2:19-24:

"You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that-and shudder. You foolish man, do you want evidence that faith without deeds is useless? Was not our ancestor Abraham considered righteous for what he did when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? You see that his faith and his actions were working together, and his faith was made complete by what he did. And the Scripture was fulfilled that says, 'Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness,' and he was called God's friend. You see that a person is justified by what he does and not by faith alone."

327.) PROPHECY:

PROVERBS 3:34:

"He mocks proud mockers but gives grace to the humble."

FULFILLMENT:

JAMES 4:4-7:

"You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world is hatred toward God? Anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. Or do you think Scripture says without reason that the Spirit he caused to live in us envies intensely? But he gives us more grace. That is why the Scripture says, 'God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.' Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you."

He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake. Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.

332.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 40:6-8:

"A voice says, 'Cry out.' And I said, 'What shall I cry?' 'All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field. The grass withers and the flowers fall, because the breath of the Lord blows on them. Surely the people are grass. The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God stands forever.'"

FULFILLMENT:

I PETER 1:22-25:

“Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for your brothers, love one another deeply, from the heart. "For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. For, 'All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of the Lord stands forever.' And this is the word that was preached to you."

333.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 28:16:

"So this is what the Sovereign Lord says: 'See, I lay a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; the one who trusts will never be dismayed.'"

FULFILLMENT:

I PETER 2:4-6:

"As you come to him, the living Stone-rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him-you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. For in Scripture it says: 'See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame.'"

They stumble because they disobey the message-which is also what they were destined for."

"He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth."

FULFILLMENT:

I PETER 2:19-22:

"For it is commendable if a man bears up under the pain of unjust suffering because he is conscious of God. But how is it to your credit if you receive a

beating for doing wrong and endure it? But if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God. To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps. 'He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth.'"

337.) PROPHECY:

ISAIAH 53:5-9:

“But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth. By oppression and judgment he was taken away. And who can speak of his descendants? For he was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgression of my people he was stricken. He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth.”

FULFILLMENT:

I PETER 2:23-25:

I PETER 3:8-12:
